active citizenship.



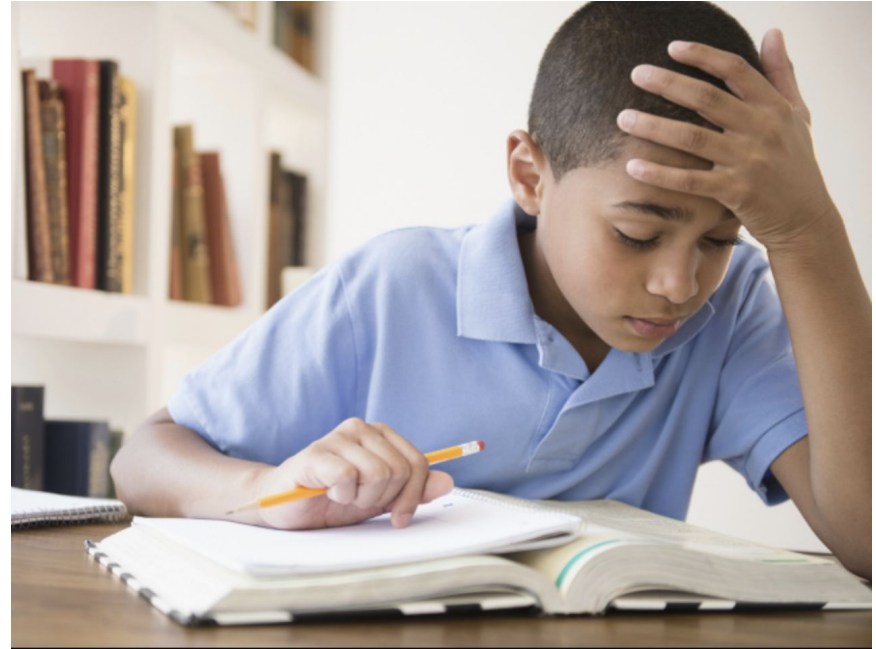
